## Results

### Dismissal Obtained in a Fraudulent Claim Matter

We secured the dismissal of a fraudulent claim against our insurance carrier client in a New York No-Fault/PIP Action. We argued the medical provider's assignor was involved in a staged loss/fraudulent accident in order to obtain No-Fault/PIP benefits. In support of the defense, an SIU affidavit and the transcript of an Examination Under Oath (EUO)

from the assignor were submitted, which included facts that casted doubt on the legitimacy of the accident. These included details such as the lack of an official police report, the insurance policy having been purchased right before the accident, and the inability of the assignor to remember key details of the accident. After a successful argument at the arbitration, the arbitrator ruled in favor of our client.
